Banning Stagecoach Days Parade **Rules and Regulations**

Thank you for requesting an application to participate in the Banning Stagecoach Days Parade. Below are the rules and regulations for your review

1. You must agree to follow the rules and direction of the parade committee.
2. Please make sure your application is complete and legible.
3. Due to the danger of physical injury, insurance requirements and littering problems, all parade participants are forbidden to throw anything from their entry. Do not in any fashion encourage spectators to come onto the parade route.
4. If you need music to be played by the announcer for the purpose of judging your entry. Your selection must be no longer than 1 minute. (Causing your entry to stop for only 1 minute in front of the judges on the parade route)
5. All entries are required to maintain a continuous forward motion during the parade. No stopping unless directed by parade committee member or at designated performance areas. Parade committee will assist in maintaining a consistent flow of traffic for the duration of the parade. No gaps between parade entries of more than 20 feet.
6. The Stagecoach Days Festival does not accept responsibility for traveling expenses, food, or lodging of any entry.
7. Check-in closes promptly at 9:15 am. Entries **MUST** be checked in prior to this time. Participant check-in will be at Hargrave and Ramsey Streets
8. Parade entry number will be distributed day of the parade at the check-in table.
9. Absolutely no political statement may be made on your entry. Violation of this will result in immediate removal from the parade.
10. Awards ceremony will take place in the entertainment area at Dysart Park (located at South 22nd Street) immediately following the parade.
11. Deadline for entry into the Parade is September 1, 2010. No entry applications will be accepted after this date. (Marching Band deadline is extended to September 5, 2010. This is for Marching Bands only.)
